We will deal with any negative behaviours just as we would if school were open – your parents and carers will remain informed, and there will be consequences to your actions.




We expect active participation in the Live Lessons – all work must be completed to the best of your ability, and any deadlines must be met

We need you to have a suitable a device with internet connection for you to access the Live Lessons – let school know as soon as possible if this is a problem for you, so we can help.



We need you to work somewhere calm, and quiet. Remove any distractions – you should not be using your phones or any other devices whilst you are accessing a Live Lesson.
