Dear parents/carers of Year 7 students,

As we approach the Easter break, we wanted to inform you of some upcoming changes to the Year 7 timetable.

So far this year, there have been seven tutor groups in Year 7. After Easter, that number will be reduced to six. Students in 7VS will be distributed amongst the remaining six tutor groups. This is to allow their tutor to work with another year group.

As a result of this change, some student timetables may be slightly different. All students will still access the same broad, balanced, and ambitious curriculum – they just might have different classmates and different teachers upon their return from the break.
