Positive student relationships


- A chance to develop a sense of healthy competition, team-working and supporting house-mates.

Members of staff will be allocated a house, so there will always be someone to cheer them on and support them in getting involved in house events.


For house pride, each student will have a badge on their blazer to represent their house. Like their blazer, this should be worn at all times as this will help teachers awarding points to the correct house.

Structure
