

Year 11 Exam Period - Key information

Study leave

There is no 'study leave' - Year 11 students are expected to attend school everyday until Monday 16th June, including days when they do not have exams - key lessons and revision sessions will be taking place everyday during the exam period.

Once a student has completed a course, the lessons for that subject will be used for revising other subjects.

Examinations

Social media will be updated daily with information on exams and revision events taking place the next day. All examinations begin at either 9am or 1pm. For 9am examinations, pre-exam briefings will take place at 8:30am. Breakfast will be provided. For afternoon examinations, students must return to lessons afterwards until the end of the school day.

Examination Expectations

Student's behaviour and conduct must be exemplary during examinations. Students must wear full uniform during examinations. Hoodies or clothes with text / print are not permitted - students wearing such items will not be permitted into the examination venues. Students who do not comply with examination expectations will not be invited to the Prom or the Leaver's Assembly. They also risk being disqualified from their examinations.

Leaver's Assembly

There will be a Leaver's Assembly after the Physics exam on **Monday 16th June**. Students will be permitted to participate in shirt signing during this event. No shirt signing is to take place before this event - doing so will result in being disinvited from the Prom and the Leaver's Assembly.

Prom Passport

The Prom is a reward for students who have made a positive contribution to school and taken their studies seriously. To be sure of an invite, students have been given a Prom Passport requiring them to show evidence of attending after school revision sessions and/or completing revision activities at home with evidence submitted to teachers.
