Police Cadet Applications Open

When Is It: Applications can be made 1 – 30th April

What It Is: South Yorkshire Police will be opening this year's Cadet Recruitment Programme for applications for the period 2022-2023. The recruitment period starts on 1 April and closes on 30 April 2022. This is a fantastic opportunity for anyone:

- Considering going into the police force
- Considering joining the armed forces
- Would like to make a positive contribution to the community
- Would like to develop confidence, leadership, communication and team working skills

Who: This opportunity is open to all Y10 and 11 (Applicants must be 15 years of age by 31 August 2022 and no older than 17 years of age by 31 March 2022)

- Applicants must be able to attend the weekly cadet night every Wednesday evening from 6:30pm-8:00pm during term-times
- Applicants may be background checked but previous incidents with the police are not always an automatic bar to joining the cadets
